

# *Barnt Green station footbridge*



# What's happening?

*Better rail services and facilities for north Worcestershire*

Network Rail is electrifying the line between Barnt Green and Bromsgrove as part of a £100m investment in the railway in north Worcestershire.

The footbridge will be replaced with a new, higher structure so overhead lines can run underneath to power electric trains. The new bridge will be completed by summer 2015.

The current footbridge will remain in place while the new one is built. Up to 15 car park spaces will be temporarily taken out of use while the work is completed for storage, equipment and site offices.

An electrified railway will allow cleaner, greener, quieter and more regular trains to run through the area, providing a better service to passengers.

As well as building a new pedestrian footbridge at Barnt Green station, a new station will be built in Bromsgrove. The railway in between the two will also be electrified and resignalled to help provide a better and more reliable service to complement the new facilities.
